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Introduction

Sumandeep Vidyapeeth, an Institution Deemed to be University was notified through Gazette notification of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Department of Higher Education Government of India, through vide notification No.F.9-46/2004-U.3 dated 17th January 2007, as “Deemed to be University” under *de novo* category. The Vidyapeeth was established under section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 through vide Notification No. F.No.6-106/2004 (CPP-1) dated 9th March, 2007 and subsequently, UGC granted permission by vide Notification No. F.6-106(1)/2004 (CPP-I) dated 26th August 2008, to start additional courses allied to Medical stream in the Department of Pharmacy, Department of Management (MBA Health care) and MBA (Hospitality Management).

The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in October 2015, carried out an assessment of the Institution and Accredited the Institution with CGPA of 3.53 on a four point scale at '**A' Grade** as per the prevailing gradation system, which is highest in the state of Gujarat. Based on the UGC notification no. F.1-1/2018(CPP-I/DU), dated 19th June 2018, the Commission has graded Sumandeep Vidyapeeth as Category- I Deemed to be University, as per the provisions of UGC [Categorization of Universities (only) for Grant of Graded Autonomy] Regulations, 2018.

The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, Government of India through its notification no. F.9-46/2004-U.3, dated: 16th December 2019, has extended the Deemed to be University status of Sumandeep Vidyapeeth from 17th January 2012 onwards.

Sumandeep Vidyapeeth imparts quality Healthcare Education and Training, and provides affordable, Scientific, Evidence-based health care, inculcating ethical and moral values in the students. The Institution emphasizes on Evidence Based and Community based Research. 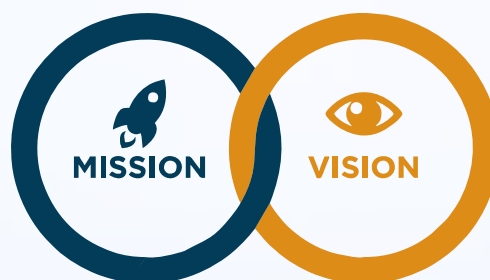

Brief History of the Sumandeep Vidyapeeth An Institution Deemed to University Institution.



Sumandeep Vidyapeeth is an institution deemed to be university notified by Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India vide notification No. F.9-46/2004-U.3 of the GOI, New Delhi and u/s 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 vide UGC Notification No. F.No.6-1-6/2004 (CPP-1) dated 3rd March, 2007.

Sumandeep Vidyapeeth has seven constituent institutes which offer Under Graduate programs like MBBS, BDS, BPT, B.Pharm, Pharm D, B.Sc (Nursing), PB B.Sc. (Nursing), ANG, GNM and B.Sc. (Paramedical) etc., Post Graduate programs like MD, MS, MDS, MPT, M.Sc. (Nursing), M.Pharm, Pharm D PB, MBA (Healthcare), M.Sc. (Para-Medical) etc., Diploma program in Para-Medical sciences and Super-specialty program like M.Ch. and D.M. All the programs offered by Sumandeep Vidyapeeth are approved by statutory bodies viz. MCI, DCI, PCI, INC, IAP and UGC. The Sumandeep Vidyapeeth imparts quality medical education and training and provide affordable, scientific, evidence-based health care, inculcate a culture of enquiry in faculty and students, leading to a life time habit of ethical practice and community-oriented research. Sumandeep Vidyapeeth is awarded with NAAC 'A' Grade with 3.53 CGPA out of 4 which is highest in state of Gujarat.

Salient Features

1. 1360 bedded, multidisciplinary, Super-specialty Dhiraj Hospital, central clinical lab and well-equipped mobile clinics are provided for teaching, learning and clinical training and uniformity in exposure of students to practical and clinical requirement.
2. The curriculum given by the statute is value added by incorporating elements of unique practice of "Evidence Based Education System". This ensures emphasis on exposing students very early on to elements of evidence searching, validation and their proper utilization in patient care and research.
3. The curriculum has rich academic, clinical and research matrix, intense community orientation, emphasis on professional skills, employability skills, ethics and code of conduct, soft skills and holistic personality development. The subjects are integrated over the entire length of respective courses with their applied aspects.
4. Practice of unique Continuous Cumulative Evaluation System (CCES)
5. The public health approach ensures priority of interface with the public through compulsory Community postings, multi-diagnostic camps, social welfare programs etc.
6. Comprehensive feedback is taken, analyzed and improvements are done in areas identified.
7. To meet the extensive academic, clinical, research and co-academic activities, Sumandeep Vidyapeeth has highly qualified experienced teaching staff and technically sound non-teaching staff.
8. Sumandeep Vidyapeeth has implemented mechanism for evaluation of teachers by students and alumni to improve the quality of teaching & learning process.
9. The innovations such as ICT enabled teaching, Reflective learning, Simulation based training, Evidence Based Medicine, Evidence Based Dentistry, emphasis on development of required skills, knowledge, and attitude to practice health profession.
10. Problem Based Learning, student assisted teaching, self-directed learning, and medical humanities are practiced.
11. Sumandeep Vidyapeeth promotes research, publications, collaboration, and faculty development programs.
12. Sumandeep Vidyapeeth has latest augmented Learning Resource Centre (LRC) which is having large numbers of collection of books & journals, including e-database, which is open 24x7 days.
13. IT and Wi-Fi enabled Laboratories, Hospitals, Research Infrastructure, Library, Mess and dining facility, Hostel facility for boys and girls, Transportation facilities, 24-hour electricity supply, campus with RO drinking water system, Health Hygiene and Waste disposal facilities, Water recycling STP plant, Landscaped garden, Parks and parking facilities, 24-hour maintenance services, safety & security facilities are provided for better campus experience of the student community.
14. Stringent Anti-Ragging measures, Anti-discrimination, Anti-sexual harassment measures and Grievances Redressal systems are built into the matrix of the Sumandeep Vidyapeeth administration.
15. Multi-centric Convention Centre, International standard sports complex, yoga Centre and Amphitheater are provided in the campus.

Brief Annual Report

A. Milestones achieved so far Since inception:

The institute has got Accredited with A grade scoring 3.53. out 4 on CGPA scale. The institute has conducted various faculty development programs, student support programs. The institute has established a Tobacco Cessation center in the ambit of department of Public health dentistry. The institute has also established a conscious sedation center unit by Department of Pedodontics and preventive dentistry. The institute has Signed a MOU with special Olympics Bharat and PAHER university for outreach research and academic exchange.

B. Significant Achievement during the academic year 2018-19:

In the current year the institute has implemented 3 value added courses on; Minimally Invasive Fixed Prosthodontics, Clinical use of Platelet Rich Derivatives and Nitrous Oxide Inhalation Sedation. The institute has 1 externally funded research project by Gujarat Biotechnology Research Centre and 5 SV funded research projects. A total 30 linkages were established in this year. 2 post graduate students received Innovation Awards. A total of 13 publication was done by various faculties of the institute. The institute has conducted program on Gender sensitization. 22 outreach programs were conducted during this year. The Alumni chapter of the institute conducted a program on Career Guidance. The institute also conducted a National level workshop on E-content development in health sciences 24th to 26 June 2019 in collaboration with NITTTR. Sports and cultural activity was conducted in the form of Samanvay 2019 where a Total No. of UG students – 359 and – 73 PG students had participated.

C. Best practices/innovations in academics, research & Management with their impact

Evidence Based Education system (EBES)

The innovative practice of evidence based education system was introduced in Sumandeep Vidyapeeth from Year 2007. In India this system is followed in Sumandeep Vidyapeeth only.

Learning has always been more productive when it is student centric. Participation of the students in teaching learning is equally important as is teachers' involvement in teaching. Conventional methods of teaching and learning though have been followed for years; newer techniques have been used introduced as evidence based effective teaching and learning methods. Amongst various methods Flipped Class room concept was identified by the institution of KM Shah Dental College and Hospital to be incorporated in teaching.

D. Institutional Social Responsibility and Community outreach activities:

Gender sensitization program was conducted.

Celebration of Energy Conservation Day was performed by Department of Periodontology on 14/12/18. Energy conservation is the need of the hour. Sensitization for energy conservation is a prime requirement given the current exploitation of the energy resources available. Thus a brief exposure to energy conservation is required. The program had included sensitization of teaching staff, non-teaching staff and students on energy conservation and implementation of it in daily life. A total number of 74 students, teaching and non – teaching staff of KM Shah Dental College and Hospital benefited from this program. A street play on energy conservation was organised by the interns for the patients. An e-poster competition was also organised. Local media and newspapers had also covered the event. A total of 22 outreach program were conducted by the institute in various villages in and around Piparia. World health day and world Aids day was also celebrated by the institute.

1. IPR Seminar (Guest Lecture on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR))

This lecture provided information about the importance of IPR in healthcare research as well as awareness about the way we need to search patent and also knowledgeable about the filing procedure of the IPR to our participants. Lecture was followed by questions answers session. Queries were resolved and appreciated.

2. ICHGCP workshop (Training program conducted by SVIEC, Research Cell)

Date: 7th September 2018

- ☑ The Event Mr. Devesh Verma, the trainer, talked about the History and Principles of GCP and Current Status of Clinical Research in India. Mr. Devesh continued the next session to impart knowledge on all the participants about roles and responsibilities of all the stake holders of Clinical Research as per GCP. Post lunch session by Dr. Shreya Shah who shared her knowledge of current updates on ICMR 2017 guidelines. Following to this, Mrs. Nirali Soni talked about importance and process of Informed Consent. At last Mr. Ronak Shah conducted a discussion round on few of the case scenarios pertaining to clinical research. The Program then ended up with participant's questionnaire & feedback analysis and then certificate distribution.

Date: 23rd November 2018

- ☑ The trainer- Mr. Gajendrasinh Chanchu initiated his talk with the History and Principles of GCP with reference to Nuremberg's Code, Declaration of Helsinki, ICH-GCP E6 and ICMR biomedical research ethics guidelines 2017. He further elaborated on roles and responsibilities of each member of IEC especially for lay person and social scientist regarding the review of informed consent documents. He provided an overview of adverse event reporting system prevalent in various reputed CROs in correlation to EC activities. Post-lunch session included information about how to handle protocol deviation, various techniques of root cause analysis and determination of corrective and preventive action. The workshop ended up with members' verbal feedback and certificate distribution.

- ☑ Ms. Bhoomika Vaghasiya, The trainer, started the training with brief introduction of ICH-GCP, its formation and its four components: Quality, Safety, Efficacy and Miscellaneous. She also provided useful insights on ethical aspects to be reviewed in trial protocols to the members.
