

The 26th meeting of the Dental Board of Studies was scheduled in the Conference Room KMSDCH, SV on 3rd and 5th November, 2018 respectively at 11.00 am.

The discussion on the Agenda were as follows:

**Agenda 1**: To review the criteria for promotion of teaching staff as per the notification from Registrar's office vide letter no: SV/R/2018/AC/2224, dated 21/09/2018.

The Dean presented the criteria for promotion. The members deliberated extensively on the same. It was unanimously agreed to follow the criteria for promotion of faculty in KMSDCH be followed according to Dental Council of India, 2017 guidelines.

Agenda 2: CCES: Proposal to revise weightage of Continuous Cumulative Evaluation System (CCES) in Internal Assessment marks for undergraduate students of K.M. Shah Dental College & Hospital. Dr. Ramya presented the need of the suggestion to have 40% weightage for CCES in Internal Assessment marks with a background of a previous University meeting with the Vice Chancellor, SV where the suggestion was made and asked to be passed through the institution's Board Of Studies.

In line with the suggestion proposed by the sub-committee of the Academic Council for CCES, and the presentation made, it was unanimously suggested to propose weightage of CCES to be modified as 40% separately in each Theory and Practical Internal Assessment Marks of all courses in BDS program.

Agenda 3: BDS Examinations: Proposal to modify examiner pattern for BDS University Examination.

Dr. Rajesh Sethuraman presented the agenda pertaining to modification of examiner pattern.

It was unanimously suggested by the members to suggest the following examiner pattern for University examinations:

Agenda 4: BRE: To propose the BRE policy. (Annexure I)

Dr. Anshula Deshpande presented the BRE policy draft. After deliberations it was unanimously decided to adopt the suggested BRE Policy of the BRE cell for Theory and Practical BRE sessions.

Agenda 5: Proposal to conduct Lectures/Seminars/Course to be incorporated in the Intern Curriculum.

Dean madam presented the DCI CDE regulations which mentions few topics to be conducted for Interns.

The Members unanimously agreed upon including the lecture series as capacity building training programs on Basic Life support, Soft skills and communication, infection control and waste management and practice management to be conducted by various departments of KMSDCH as identified by the students' Section. The lectures and workshops will be conducted within the college working hours itself. These suggestions shall be forwarded to the Academic council for acceptance.

**Agenda 6:** To consider the suggestions in the curriculum suggested by the Department of Public Health Dentistry

Dr. Sweta Singh presented the need to modify the interns' curriculum by including contribution in needs assessment of the said community or groups during their RHS posting. This is to be done by involving local community leaders viz. village sarpanch, ASHA workers, social workers etc and collect demographic and socio-environmental information of the community served by the interns.

The members unanimously agreed upon the proposal for interns to extend contribution in needs assessment of the said community or groups during their RHS posting.

3.5 Suggestions of Department of Orthodontics

The Department proposed the list of examiners to the Board for approval. The list was approved to be proposed to the Academic Council for approval.

3.6 Suggestions of Department of Prosthodontics

The Department proposed to start ONE value added certificate courses on Minimally invasive fixed prosthodontics. The details of the same were presented. The board accepted to propose the certificate course to the Academic Council for approval.

AGENDA 4: Any other matter with the permission of the chair.

- 4.1 Department of Public Health Dentistry:
  - 4.1.1 Dr. Sweta Singh presented the difficulty in conducting Dental camps due to unavailability of functional Mobile Dental van and/ or transportation support from University. The Department had in the past presented the problems in writing to concerned authorities for solution. The Board suggested that the matter be again represented to the Chief Administrative Officer to provide a bus exclusively for dental camps.
  - 4.1.2 Dr. Sweta Singh also proposed the establishment of Tobacco Cessation Centre by the Department of Public Health Dentistry. The centre has been a mandatory requirement by the Dental Council of India. Dean Madam presented that preliminary works regarding the establishment, Infrastructure and Staff has been identified. She presented that the Centre has been proposed by the Department of Public Health Dentistry and shall be run by them. The members of the board accepted the proposal and decided to propose the same for approval to the Academic council.






