REGULATIONS FOR WITHDRAWAL FROM THE COURSE/PROGRAM

In case of point (5#) in the table above, if the student leaves the course or in the event of cancellation of his / her admission, due to any reason whatsoever, anytime after the 30 days of formally notified last date of admission, the student is liable for payment of the fees for the remaining period of complete tenure of his/her program of study, to the Sumandeep Vidyapeeth Deemed to University. In that event, Sumandeep Vidyapeeth has all the rights to recover the payment of the fees for the remaining period of complete tenure of his/her program of study, by redeeming unconditional bank guarantee / Un-dated cheques submitted by the student at the time of admission or through any other appropriate legal procedure against the student/parent/guardian for the recovery of entire outstanding amount against him/her.
