MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MOU agreed and entered into on this 5th day of January, Two Thousand and Eighteen between **Department of Pharmacy (DOP)**, **Sumandeep Vidyapeeth**, **Vadodara** and **Karnataka college of Pharmacy (KCP)**, **Bangaluru** India, for facilitating collaborative training in Hospital wards.

A. PREAMBLE

The Department of Pharmacy recognizes their strengths in research and education in the discipline of industrial and clinical pharmacy and mutual interest engaging in academic and research works. This is an opportunity for Department of Pharmacy(DOP); Sumandeep Vidyapeeth deemed to be University, (NAAC A grade) and Karnataka college of Pharmacy, Bangaluru(KCP) to work together synergistically based on the complementarities of our objectives and of our strengths to facilitate collaborative training. DOP and KCP both parties agree to establish a programme for collaborative training in areas of mutual interest and in accordance with terms and conditions set for in this memorandum of understanding.

ABOUT DEPARTMENT OF PHARMACY SUMANDEEP VIDYAPEETH

DOP is running B. Pharm, M. Pharm, Pharm D and Pharm D (PB) programme with sufficient facilities as prescribed by pharmacy council of India and a state-of-art 1300 bedded multispecialty Dhiraj General Hospital in the campus run by the same management. DOP is able:

- i. To provide well trained Pharm D (Doctor of Pharmacy) and B. Pharm (Bachelor of Pharmacy).
 - ii. Capacity building for increasing trained professionals in the field of health care.

ABOUT KARNATAKA COLLEGE OF PHARMACY, BANGALORE

KCP is affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Bangalore; Pharmacy Council of India and AICTE. It is running B. Pharm, M. Pharm, Pharm D, Pharm D (PB) and PhD programs with sufficient facilities as prescribed by PCI. It has signed in a MOU with The Bangalore Baptist Hospital (BBH) for clinical training. BBH is a 350 bed tertiary care, NABH accredited hospital.



B. OBJECTIVES

The goal of this Memorandum of Understanding between DOP and KCP is to foster collaborative training in their respective hospitals to provide advancement in the Pharmaceutical care.

EXCHANGE OF PHARM D students for imparting training and learning in the hospital wards for Pharmaceutical care of patients between aforementioned Institutes.

- 1.1 RECOGNIZING the importance of institutions in promoting collaboration for contribution towards learning and training of Pharm D students in hospitals.
- 1.2 THE PARTIES HEREBY agree to establish collaboration according to terms and conditions set out in the articles following hereunder

C.) ARTICLE I: SCOPE OF THE COLLABORATION

The general purpose of this MOU is to facilitate training of Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm D) students in wards during their internship for an exchange program of 2-3 months between the parties based upon the principles of mutual benefit and may include the following general cooperation areas;

General areas of cooperation

- 2.1 Joint educational and research activities including Evidence Based Medicine System,
- 2.2 Exchange of visiting scholars for the purpose of conducting research in Pharmacy Practice. The individual visitors will be responsible for the cost of such as Hospital fees (if any) accommodation and own travel etc.
- 2.3 Discussion for the exchange of undergraduate and postgraduate students for collaborative or independent research based on the policies of both institutions,
- 2.4 Extend invitations for attending scholarly and technical meetings as well as National and International conferences,
- 2.5 Neither institution is responsible for any financial support under this MOU. Individual scholars will make all arrangements by written agreement, which will be applicable to each particular situation.



D. ARTICLE II: THE AGREEMENT

- 3.1 At Sumandeep Vidyapeeth, Vadodara, this MOU will be administered by Head, Department of Pharmacy, (University Representative).
- 3.2 At Karnataka College this MOU will be administered by Dean Karnataka college of Pharmacy, Bangaluru, (University Representative).

The parties may enter into specific written agreements under authority of this MOU to clarify and define the nature, extent and terms of operation for the proposed collaborations, including intellectual property ownership and funding issues.

E. ARTICLE III: GENERAL TERMS

- 4.1 This MOU does not generally permit the exchange of students at the undergraduate or postgraduate level unless otherwise stated herein. Where students are involved directly in the training covered by this MOU, the exchange of graduate and post-doctoral students can be accommodated by specific written agreement contained herein as follows:
- 4.2 This MOU is not intended to, and does not create any right, benefit, or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or equity, by either party, its officers, employees, or agents against the other party, its officers, employees, or agents.
- 4.3 Nothing in this MOU obligates either party to commit or transfer any funds, assets, or other resources in support of projects or activities between the parties unless expressly stated in this agreement.
- 4.4 The activities of this MOU must be carried out in accordance with appropriate laws and regulations existing in each country and institution.
- 4.5 With regard to intellectual property, each institution will adhere to the intellectual property laws of its respective nation. Intellectual property developed during the visit of a faculty or student visitor will be governed by the rules of the host institution unless otherwise specified by an alternate agreement. In general, the two institutions shall jointly own jointly developed intellectual property resulting from clearly defined collaborative projects. Whenever one institution receives any information from the partner under a clearly defined non-disclosure agreement, necessary steps will be taken to protect the intellectual property received.



F. ARTICLE IV: DURATION

This MOU may be modified by mutual written consent. The Agreement will be in effect from the date of signature for a period of five years. It shall be renewed upon mutual written agreement. This agreement may be terminated by either side at 6 months written notice.

G. DISPUTES:

If there is any dispute regarding terms and conditions or any other dispute arise then the disputes will be sent to the Arbitrator, who may be appointed by mutual consent of both parties (institutions) jointly and the decision of Arbitrator will be binding to both the institution and shall be final.
